

## Indie Pop



Both *indie* and *indie pop* had originally referred to the same thing during the late 1970s. Inspired more by punk rock's DIY ethos than its style, guitar bands were formed on the then-novel premise that one could record and release their own music instead of having to procure a record contract from a major label.

Indie pop borrows heavily from Western pop

song conventions and structures with extensive use of, for example, major chords, hooks, common time and a "consistent and noticeable rhythmic element" i.e. the beat.

Indie pop was an unprecedented contrast from the gritty and serious tones of previous underground rock styles, as well as being a

departure from the glamour of contemporary pop music. Distinguished from the angst and abrasiveness of its indie rock counterpart, the majority of indie pop borrows not only the strippeddown quality of punk, but also "the sweetness and catchiness of mainstream pop".



Arctic Monkeys are an English indie Pop band formed in Sheffield in 2002. The group consists of Alex Turner (lead vocals, guitar, keyboards), Jamie Cook (guitar, keyboards), Nick O'Malley (bass



guitar, backing vocals), and Matt Helders (drums, backing vocals). Former band member Andy Nicholson (bass guitar, backing vocals) left the band in 2006 shortly after their debut album was released.

**Pop** is a genre of popular music that originated in its modern form during the mid-1950s in the United States and the United Kingdom. *Rock* and *pop* music remained roughly synonymous until the late 1960s, after which *pop* became associated with music that was more commercial, ephemeral, and accessible.

Although much of the music that appears on record charts is seen as pop music, the genre is distinguished from chart music. Much pop music also borrows elements from other styles such as rock, urban, dance, Latin, and country.

## Characteristics

Characteristics of pop music include an aim of appealing to a general



audience, rather than to a particular sub-culture or ideology. There are three identifying characteristics of pop music: light entertainment, commercial imperatives, and personal identification. Pop music is more conservative than other music genres such as folk, blues, country, and tradition. Many pop songs do not contain

themes of resistance, opposition, or political themes, rather focusing more on love and relationships. Therefore, pop music does not challenge its audiences socially, and does not cause political activism. The main purpose of pop music is to create revenue. It is not a medium of free articulation of the people. Instead, pop music seeks to supply the nature of personal desire and achieve the instant empathy with cliche personalities, sterotypes, and melodrama that appeals to listeners. It is mostly about how much revenue pop music makes for record companies.


The main medium of pop music is the song, often between two and a half and three and a half minutes in length, generally marked by a consistent and noticeable rhythmic element, a mainstream style and a simple traditional structure. The structure of many popular songs is that of a verse and a chorus, the chorus serving as the portion of the track that is designed to stick in the ear through simple repetition both musically and lyrically. The beat and the melodies tend to be simple, with limited harmonic accompaniment. The lyrics of modern pop songs typically focus on simple themes – often love and romantic relationships – although there are notable exceptions.

# **ROCK MUSIC**

**Rock music** is a genre of popular music that originated as "rock and roll" in the United States in the late 1940s and early 1950s.

It has its roots in 1940s and 1950s rock and roll, a style that drew directly from the blues and rhythm and blues genres of African-American music and from country music.

For instrumentation, rock has centered on the electric guitar, usually as part of a rock group with electric bass, drums, and one or more singers.



Like pop music, lyrics often stress romantic love but also address a wide variety of other themes that are frequently social or political.

By the late 1960s "classic rock" period, a number of distinct rock music subgenres had emerged. New genres that emerged included progressive rock, glam rock, which highlighted showmanship and visual style, and the diverse and enduring subgenre of heavy metal, which emphasized volume, power, and speed.

From the 1990s, alternative rock began to dominate rock music and break into the mainstream in the form of grunge, Britpop, and indie rock.

The 2010s saw a slow decline in rock music's mainstream popularity and cultural relevancy, with hip hop surpassing it as the most popular genre in the United States.

In the 2020s, the COVID-19 pandemic had a major impact on the rock scene, with many live performances being cancelled or postponed, and some artists resorting to online performances; the decade has also seen a revival of pop punk music.

Rock music has also embodied and served as the vehicle for cultural and social movements. Inheriting the folk tradition of the protest song, rock music has been associated with political activism as well as changes in social attitudes to race, sex, and drug use, and is often seen as an expression of youth revolt against adult consumerism and conformity. At the same time, it has been commercially highly successful, leading to charges of selling out.

The sound of rock is traditionally centered on the amplified electric guitar, which emerged in its modern form in the 1950s with the popularity of rock and roll.

Classically, a rock band takes the form of a quartet whose members cover one or more roles, including vocalist, lead guitarist, rhythm guitarist, bass guitarist, drummer, and often keyboard player or other instrumentalist.



Unlike many earlier styles of popular music, rock lyrics have dealt with a wide range of themes, including romantic love,

sex, rebellion against "The Establishment", social concerns, and life styles. The predominance of white, male, and often middle class musicians in rock music has often been noted, and rock has been seen as an appropriation of black musical forms for a young, white and largely male audience. As a result, it has also been seen to articulate the concerns of this group in both style and lyrics.

In the new millennium, the term *rock* has occasionally been used as a **blanket term** including forms like pop music, **reggae music**, **soul music**, and even **hip hop**, which it has been influenced with but often contrasted through much of its history.



The Beatles were an English rock band formed in Liverpool in 1960. The group, whose bestknown line-up comprised John Lennon, Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Starr, are regarded as the most influential band of all time. They were integral to the development of 1960s counterculture and popular music's recognition as an art form. <sup>1</sup> Their sound



incorporated elements of classical music and traditional pop in innovative ways; the band later explored music styles ranging from ballads and Indian music to psychedelia and hard rock.

As pioneers in recording, songwriting and artistic presentation, the Beatles revolutionised many aspects of the music industry and were often publicised as leaders of the era's youth and sociocultural movements.

As their popularity grew into the intense fan frenzy

dubbed "Beatlemania", the band acquired the nickname "the Fab Four".

By early 1964, the Beatles were international stars, leading the "British Invasion" of the United States pop market, breaking numerous sales records, and inspiring Britain's cultural resurgence.

The Beatles are the best-selling music act of all time, with estimated sales of 600 million units worldwide. They hold the record for most number-one albums on the UK Albums Chart (15), most number-one hits on the *Billboard* Hot 100 chart (20), and most singles sold in the UK (21.9 million). In 2004 and 2011, the group topped *Rolling Stone*'s lists of the greatest artists in history. *Time* magazine named them among the 20th century's 100 most important people.

## **The Rolling Stones**



The rolling stones are an English **rock** band formed in London in 1962. Active for almost six decades, they are one of the most popular and enduring bands of the rock era. The Rolling Stones pioneered the gritty, heavier-driven sound that came to define **hard rock**.

Rooted in blues and early rock and roll, the Rolling Stones started out playing covers and were at the forefront of the British Invasion in 1964, also being identified with the youthful and rebellious counterculture of the 1960s.

They found great success with their material as "(I Can't Get No) Satisfaction" (1965), "Get Off of My Cloud" (1965) and "Paint It Black" (1966) became international No. 1

By 2007 they had four of the top five highest-grossing concert tours of all time.

Blue & Lonesome (2016), became their twelfth UK number-one album.

The Rolling Stones' estimated record sales of 200 million makes them one of the best-selling music artists of all time. The band has won three Grammy Awards and a Grammy Lifetime Achievement Award. They were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1989 and the UK Music Hall of Fame in 2004. In 2019, *Billboard* magazine ranked the Rolling Stones second on their list of the "Greatest Artists of All Time" based on US chart success. They are ranked fourth on *Rolling Stone*'s list of the Greatest Artists of All Time.

AC/DC are an Australian rock band formed in Sydney in 1973 by Scottish-born brothers Malcolm and Angus Young.<sup>1</sup> Their music has been variously described as hard rock, blues rock, and heavy metal, but the band themselves call it simply "rock and roll".

AC/DC underwent several line-up changes before releasing their first album, 1975's *High Voltage*. Membership subsequently stabilised around the Young brothers, singer Bon Scott, drummer Phil Rudd, and bassist Mark Evans. The album *Back in Black*launched AC/DC to new heights of success and became one of the best selling albums of all time.

The band's eighth studio album, *For Those About to Rock We Salute You* (1981), was their first album to reach number one in the United States. The band's line-up remained the same for twenty years, until 2014 with Malcolm Young's retirement due to early-onset dementia (he died in 2017) and Rudd's legal troubles.

AC/DC have sold more than 200 million records worldwide, including 75 million albums in the United States, making them the ninth-highest-selling artist in the United States and the 16thbest-selling artist worldwide. *Back in Black* has sold an estimated 50 million units worldwide, making it the third-highest-selling album by any artist, and the highest-selling album by any band. AC/DC ranked fourth on VH1's list of the "100 Greatest Artists of Hard Rock" and were named the seventh "Greatest Heavy Metal Band of All Time" by MTV. In 2004, AC/DC ranked No. 72 on the *Rolling Stone* list of the "100 Greatest Artists of All Time"

## scorpons

**Scorpions** are a German rock band formed in 1965 in Hanover by Rudolf Schenker. Since the band's inception, its musical style has ranged from hard rock, heavy metal, and glam metal.



The lineup from 1978 to 1992 was the most successful incarnation of the group, and included Klaus Meine (vocals), Rudolf Schenker (rhythm guitar), Matthias Jabs (lead guitar), Francis Buchholz (bass), and Herman Rarebell (drums).

The Scorpions changed their sound towards hard rock/heavy metal, mixed with rock power ballads. Throughout the 1980s the group received positive reviews

and critical acclaim from music critics, and experienced commercial success with the

albums Animal Magnetism (1980), Blackout (1982), Love at First Sting (1984), the live recording World Wide Live (1985), Savage Amusement (1988) and Best of Rockers 'n' Ballads (1989), which is their best-selling compilation album.

Scorpions' eleventh studio album *Crazy World* (1990) was also well-received, and included the song "Wind of Change", a symbolic anthem of the political changes in Eastern Europe in the late 1980s and early 1990s and the fall of the Berlin Wall. It is one of the best-selling singles in the world with over fourteen million copies sold. Scorpions have sold over 110 million records in total. They have released 18 studio albums, 27 compilation albums and 74 singles. Six of their singles have reached number one on the charts in different countries. Their albums, singles, compilations and video releases have reached gold, platinum and multi-platinum status 200 times in different countries.

*Rolling Stone* described the Scorpions as "the heroes of heavy metal", and MTV called them "Ambassadors of Rock". The Scorpions were ranked number 46 on VH1's *Greatest Artists of Hard Rock* programme, with "Rock You Like a Hurricane" at number 18 on VH1's list of the *100 Greatest Hard Rock Songs*. "Still Loving You" ranked 22nd place among the greatest ballads. They have received prestigious awards such as three World Music Awards, a star on the Hollywood Rock wall, and a presence in the permanent exhibition of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. In 2015, the group celebrated its 50th anniversary.

**Pink Floyd** were an English rock band formed in London in 1964. Gaining an early following as one of the first British psychedelic groups, they were distinguished for their extended compositions, sonic experimentation, philosophical lyrics and elaborate live shows. They became a leading band of the progressive rock genre, cited by some as the greatest progressive rock band of all time.

Pink Floyd were founded in 1964 by Syd Barrett (guitar, lead vocals), Nick Mason (drums), Roger Waters (bass guitar, vocals), Richard Wright (keyboards, vocals) and Bob Klose (guitars)

Waters became the primary lyricist and thematic leader, devising the concepts behind the band's peak success with the albums *The Dark Side of the Moon* (1973), *Wish You Were Here* (1975), *Animals* (1977) and *The Wall* (1979). The musical film based on *The Wall, Pink Floyd* – *The Wall* (1982), won two BAFTA Awards.

The band produced two more albums—*A Momentary Lapse of Reason* (1987) and *The Division Bell* (1994)—and toured in support of both albums before entering a long period of inactivity. The last Pink Floyd studio album, *The Endless River* (2014), was based on



unreleased material from the *Division Bell* recording sessions.

By 2013, Pink Floyd had sold more than 250 million records worldwide, making them one of the best-selling music artists of all time. *Wish You Were Here, The Dark Side of the Moon,* and *The Wall* are among the best-selling albums of all time, and the latter two have been inducted into the Grammy Hall of FameThe band also composed several film scores. They were inducted into the US Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1996 and the UK Music Hall of Fame in 2005

#### 1.EMINEM

Eminem, by name of Marshall Bruce Mathers III, (born October 17, 1972, St. Joseph, Missouri, U.S.), American rapper, record producer, and actor who was



known as one of the most-controversial and best-selling artists of the early 21st century.

Mathers had a turbulent childhood, marked by poverty and allegations of abuse. Discovered by rapper and producer Dr. Dre and signed with his company, Aftermath Records and Interscope Records, creating in 1999 his own record, Shady Records, under Interscope. To date, he has sold over 170

million records worldwide, making him one of the best-selling artists in the world, and also has the highest-selling sales of all time among rap artists. According to the Guinness Book of World Records, it also holds the record for first-week sales of a single album, with Marshall Mathers LP selling 1.76 million copies in its first week of release.

Eminem has been distinguished for his technical and lyrical skills in rap and today is considered one of the most legendary artists in the field of hip-hop, with many artists mentioning him as one of their influences. One of his best songs is lose yourself that was released in 2002.

## 2. Kanye West

Kanye Omari West born June 8, 1977, and legally named Ye since October 2021) is an American rapper, record producer, and fashion designer. Born in Atlanta and raised in Chicago, West gained recognition as a producer for Roc-A-Fella Records in the early 2000s, producing singles for several popular artists.

Intent on pursuing a solo career as a rapper, West released his debut album, The College Dropout (2004), to critical and commercial success, and founded the record label GOOD Music. He went on to experiment with a variety of musical genres on subsequent



acclaimed albums, including Late Registration (2005), Graduation (2007), and 808s & Heartbreak (2008). Drawing inspiration from maximalism and minimalism respectively, his fifth album My Beautiful Dark Twisted Fantasy (2010) and sixth album Yeezus (2013) were also released to critical and commercial successes. West also diversified musical styles on The Life of Pablo (2016) and Ye (2018), and explored Christian music on Jesus Is King (2019). After a series of delays, West's highly anticipated tenth album, Donda, was released in 2021.


West is one of the world's best-selling music artists, with more than 160 million records sold worldwide. He has won a total of 22 Grammy Awards, making him one of the most awarded artists of all time, and second most awarded rapper. Among his other awards are the Billboard Artist Achievement Award, a joint-record three Brit Awards for Best International Male Solo Artist and the Michael Jackson Video Vanguard Award. Six of his albums were included on Rolling Stone's 2020 500 Greatest Albums of All Time list; the

same publication named him one of the Songwriters of All Time. West is the tied most albums (four) topping the annual critic poll, a distinction he shares with Bob date, West has the 5th most appearances Billboard Hot 100, amassing 133 chart magazine named him one of the 100 most people in the world in 2005 and 2015.One that I really like is Ghost Town by the "YE" was released in 2018.



## 3. SNIK



**Dimitris Giannoulis** (Greek: Δημήτρης Γιαννούλης, born 4 May 1987) also known by his stage name **Snik** is a Greek rapper. In 2012 **Snik** released his first single "Thema Chronou" which reached 100,000 views on YouTube. He subsequently signed a contract with the Panik Records label. He released the first two songs on the label: "Kounisou Dipla Mou" and "Ti Zoi Mou Grafo" (with DJ Young). During this time, SNIK gained significant exposure on the internet, with many critics judging his songs negatively.

In 2015, he returned with his new single "Tony Montana" in collaboration with the rapper Light, with whom he also collaborated on the songs "Gucci Mane", "Gia Panta" and "bosses". Giannoulis stated that "Tony Montana" is his favorite song from his discography. In this period of his career, Giannoulis released the singles; "Ferrari", "Harry Houdini" and "DAB", in a collaboration with the rapper Ypo. Subsequently, he released five new songs in Greece and Cyprus, these are; "Ath", "9", "Gangsta", "Gango", "Medusa "Senorita'. The last song remains his most popular song on YouTube, having collected more than 35 million views, as of April 2021.

Giannoulis performed the song "To Gucci Forema" with Giorgos Mazonakis on Mad VMA 2018. In 2019, his song "Colpo Grosso" reached number 1 in Greece, Cyprus, Italy, Albania, and number 10 in Switzerland. 

## 3. JOYNER LUCAS

**Gary Maurice Lucas Jr.** (born August 17, 1988), better known by his stage name **Joyner Lucas**, is an American rapper, singer, and songwriter. Lucas first received widespread exposure and critical acclaim after the release of his single "Ross Capicchioni" in 2015. In June 2017, he released his fourth mixtape, *508-507-2209*, which was his first on a major label. On November 28, 2017, Lucas released his single "I'mNot Racist", which quickly went viral, gaining him further mainstream attention. The video was nominated for the Grammy Awards for the Best Music Video at the 61stGrammyAwards. Lucas was briefly signed to Atlantic Records, until he announced his departure from the label in December 2018. Since 2016, Lucas has also become known for remixing popular hip hop songs like "Gucci Gang" by Lil Pump, "Bank Account" by 21<sup>st</sup> Savage, "DNA" by Kendrick Lamar and many others. In October 2018, he announced his debut studio album *ADHD*, which was released on March 27, 2020. Out of all Joyner Lucas's songs my favorite one is Devil's Work.


